Dear Crawford County Resident:

Thank you for taking the time to report damage to your mailbox. Damage to mailboxes and posts are usually the result of snow and ice, moved by the force of the plow, not contact with a truck.

At a time when other road commissions are cutting back and have decided not to replace mailboxes under any circumstances, The Crawford County Road Commission will replace them. When you bring in a damaged mailbox, the Road Commission will replace it with a U.S. Postmaster approved Aluminum mailbox which we carry in stock. We do not replace any other kind of mailbox nor do we reimburse for any cost thereof.

The Road commission will not replace posts nor install mailboxes.

Please see below the postal regulations having to do with proper installation. An adequate post and mailbox properly installed, will not guarantee permanent placement, but will contribute greatly to the mailbox and post being able to withstand winter maintenance operations.
